There is a more technical term for the Chord Family. In standard music theory, it's called the **Harmonized Diatonic Scale**. Take a *diatonic* scale, which includes two (*dia*) kinds of intervals, Whole and Half *tones*, and *harmonize* each note in the scale by adding secondary notes according to the formula 1 - 3 - 5.

Among these 7 chords, three separate **Chord Qualities** are represented: **Major**, **Minor** and **Diminished**, and I have already labeled them for you. Here, then, is the **C Harmonized Diatonic Scale**:



Major chords use just the letter name; Minor chords add the letter m; and Diminished is dim.
